



DENTAL/PHYSICAL/VISION FORMS FOR THE 2009-2010 SCHOOL YEAR

❖ **Dental forms**

Were sent home with students presently in grades PK-4, first and fifth.

The state recommends students visit the dentist every six months but they require students in grades *Kindergarten, Second and Sixth* to provide proof of an oral examination by a licensed dentist by May 15th of that current school year.

Dental forms for students entering K, 2, & 6 should be sent to the school/nurse's office before May 15, 2010. (Dental exam should be within 18 months prior to 5/15/10.)

❖ **Physical forms**

Were sent home with students presently in grades PK-4 and fifth grade.

The state requires all new students entering school for the first time and those entering Kindergarten and sixth grade to have a complete physical and dated record of required immunizations. Students failing to have these requirements by the first day of the next school year may not be permitted to

attend school until the completed forms are returned to the school/nurse's office. Parents, there are questions you need to answer on the second side along with your signature and date.

Physical forms for students entering Kindergarten and sixth grade should be sent to the office before the first day of school (fall/2009). (Physical exam should be within 12 months of your child's birthday.)

❖ **Vision Examination forms**

Were sent home with students presently in PK-4.

New state law requires all incoming Kindergarten students to have an eye exam performed by a licensed optometrist or ophthalmologist before October 15th of that current school year. Vision forms for students entering Kindergarten should be returned to the school/nurse's office before October 15th.

If you return any of these forms during this school year, please indicate that they are for the 09-10 school year. We also suggest that you make a copy for your own file before sending the original to school.
