Behavior and Incentives

individual/class points as well as set new class and personal goals. Students will be able to work towards special activities within the classroom based on points earned.

We will be using Words Their way program again this year. There will be some changes this year as we move to more of the word study concept of the program.

Reading

4th Graders will grow in reading each day this year!
They will be reading independently, in guided reading groups, through shared reading novels and in Epic Books this year.
Good Readers become Great Readers with practice, so PLEASE encourage reading at home.

Homework Policy
