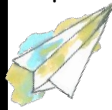

## Behavior and Incentives

## Words Their Way

## Reading

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4<sup>th</sup> Graders will grow in reading each day this year!

They will be reading independently, in guided reading groups, through shared reading novels and in Epic Books this year. Good Readers become Great Readers with practice, so PLEASE encourage reading at home.



## Homework Policy
