Father O'Hara, the Pastor, broke ground on the new school and church building on May 24, 1953, the Feast of Our Lady of the Wayside. In August 1954, the first students entered the building of OLW School. Many changes have occurred since then, but the core value of providing an excellent Catholic education to families remains intact.

Our parish makes an investment into the school and the parent volunteer organization, the Family School Association (FSA), also donates funds that they raise throughout each school year. Donations to the Annual Fund make up an additional funding source outside of current parents; *support from alumni*, *past parents and parishioners is essential to grow the Annual Fund*.

## What does the Annual Fund support?

Support of the Annual Fund underwrites a broad range of undertakings that make Our Lady of the Wayside School a great educational establishment. The Annual Fund:

- Allows the administration to invest in updated curriculum and best-practice instructional methods and materials.

- Lets us, as a small private school, retain learning resource teachers who assist students that learn at a different pace.
- Supports the general operating expenses of the school.
