Annual Severe Allergy/Medical Survey

- If your child has food allergies please fill out the Annual Severe Allergy Survey.
- If they will have an Epi-pen or inhaler at school please provide their <u>action plan</u> from their allergist or pediatrician with a picture of the student glued or taped on the sheet. We will also need a signed <u>medication release form</u> for any child that will have medication administered in school, including inhalers. We will be meeting with your child's teacher to review their medical plan for this year.

- We will be available to meet with you on Monday August 16th from 10am-7pm. If it is more convenient to meet another day or time please email us to set up a time to meet.

Photo permission form
